



Don't Mess With Haringey Campaign

We are launching our "Don't Mess With Haringey" behavioural change campaign in mid-June as a response to recent resident engagement that revealed overwhelming support for tougher measures, with 96% of residents backing fines for fly-tipping and 94% supporting penalties for dog fouling and littering.

Don't Mess With Haringey Campaign

Phase 1 of this campaign will run from mid June – mid August and will consist of an initial awareness and re-directing digital and physical campaign.


Campaign goals:

- 10% increase in fines within the first 3 months, to help with case studies
- 10% decrease in bulky waste dumping
- 15% increase in website landing page visits
- 10% increase in bulky waste booking






- We'll pick this up as soon as possible.
